

One-Month Fabric Painting Course Curriculum

Duration: 1 Month

Total Sessions: 4 (1 session per week)

Objective: Introduce learners to fabric painting techniques across different fabrics while exploring traditional and contemporary motifs.

Session 1: Cotton & Linen Fabric Painting

Fabric Material: Cotton and Linen

Theme: Kalamkari Motif

Topics Covered:

- Introduction to fabric paints, brushes, and fabric preparation.
- Understanding traditional Kalamkari design elements and motifs.
- Sketching, outlining, and colour application techniques.
- Final finishing and care instructions for painted fabrics.

Session 2: Silk Fabric Painting

Fabric Material: Silk

Theme: Pichwai Art

Topics Covered:

- Introduction to painting on silk surfaces.
- Exploring Pichwai motifs and composition styles.
- Layering, blending, and detailing techniques.
- Finishing methods for silk fabric artwork.

Session 3: Organza Fabric Painting

Fabric Material: Organza

Theme: Floral Motif

Topics Covered:

- Handling transparent and delicate fabrics.
- Creating floral compositions and colour harmony.
- Shading and dimensional effects in fabric painting.
- Preservation and display techniques.

Session 4: T-Shirt Painting

Fabric Material: T-Shirt Fabric

Theme: Abstract Painting

Topics Covered:

- Concept development and creative exploration.
- Abstract patterns, textures, and colour combinations.
- Personal project creation on a wearable product.
- Final review and course completion.
